

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT  
AN AMENDED CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE OF THE  
ANTELOPE VALLEY-EAST KERN WATER AGENCY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency (the “Agency”) intends to conduct a public hearing and amend the Agency’s Conflict of Interest Code (the “Code”) pursuant to Government Code Section 87300 et seq.

The Code incorporates by reference the Fair Political Practices Commission regulation (2 Cal. Code Regs. § 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. The Appendix of the Code designates those employees, members, officers, and consultants who are subject to the Agency’s Code. The Agency’s proposed amendment includes a new position that must be designated, and identifies positions of Agency officials who manage public investments and are not subject to the Agency’s Code, but must file statement under Government Code Section 87200 *et seq.*

Pursuant to the Governor’s Executive Order N-29-20, the proposed Code will be considered by the Board of Directors on **October 11, 2022, at 5:30 p.m.**, via a Teleconference and/or Video Conference Board Meeting. Any interested person may be present via conference-call and comment at the public meeting or may submit written comments concerning the proposed Code. The call-in information will be provided on the agenda for the October 11, 2022 Board Meeting.
